



OF-THE-MONTH AWARDS FACT SHEET

This fact sheet, developed for UNC Charlotte Housing and Residence Life, provides an overview of NRHH's Of-The-Month Awards.

WHAT IS AN OF-THE-MONTH AWARD?

An Of-The-Month (OTM) is an award recognizing outstanding achievements of students, faculty and communities on campus.

OTMs highlight accomplishments in service and recognition from the previous month. There are two categories for awards: programming and general.

HOW DOES THE PROCESS WORK?

Writing an OTM requires collecting background information on the person, event or community being nominated and writing a persuasive bid.

The nomination should be submitted to NRHH's [website](#) by the last day of the month. Winners will be notified within two weeks.

After winning, an OTM has the chance to move on to state, regional and national levels. Awards bidding will take place at university housing conferences.
