CHARLOTTE, N.C. (March 29, 2018) – On tough days, a kind gesture from a friendly face is priceless. The National Residence Hall Honorary wants to give students a chance to pay their kind peers back. Starting April 1, students can submit nominations for the Diamond Awards through NRHH's website. This award spotlights people on campus that have made a profound impact on someone's day. NRHH's Recognition Committee will read through nominations and select winners from every residence hall in three categories – residence, staff and faculty – at the end of each month.

Unlike NRHH's Of-The-Month Awards, which require a lengthy account of recognition and service, the Diamond Awards are short and simple. The nomination consists of the nominee's name, position, residence hall, and a three-sentence account of how they made their nominator feel valued. These stories, along with a picture of the winner, will be shared via Twitter during the month of their nomination.

"We hope that once the stories are public, residents start paying attention to those living around them. There is always someone who needs help, and we want to inspire students to take the initiative and lend a hand," said Cavasier Morris, president, NRHH.
