- Non-profit organization operating under the UNC System for nearly 40 years
- Our Mission: To connect North Carolina and the world
- Our Goal: To prepare North Carolina to succeed in a global economy and increasingly independent world

GLOBAL TEACHERS PROGRAM

- Since 1995, over 900 teachers have studied abroad in 16 countries
- Currently, 17 North Carolina counties benefit from 10 donor scholarships that support 26 teachers a year to participate
- Under the new Fellowship, Go Global NC will raise \$10 million to assure that one teacher from all 100 North Carolina counties will have this opportunity every year, fully funded

- 11,000 students in higher education study abroad each year⁴
- 3,972 students were enrolled in Advanced Placement language classes in 2013⁵

THE FELLOWSHIP




The Fellowship provides North Carolina's outstanding teachers with the quickest and most economical way to increase their global competence.
