


Since Go Global NC began the Global Teachers Program in 1995, over 900 teachers have studied abroad in 16 different countries. We build upon decades of expertise and leadership in the field of teacher immersion programs.

Only a small percentage of NC's 95,000 full-time teachers have ever been abroad. Surprisingly, for some the program is their first trip on an airplane. For others, it is their first trip outside of NC.
